APPLICATION FORM

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Guidance

The UK Renal Pharmacy Group (RPG) Research Award is aimed at pharmacists with an interest in renal pharmacy. The grant funding of up to £5,000 is to provide renal pharmacists with support in delivering a research project of up to 12 months in length. You will need to consider if you will be in a role to deliver the required outputs of the project over the timeline specified.

We are looking for a motivated renal pharmacist wanting to push the speciality forward who is wanting to be more research active. Obtaining an MSc qualification is an excellent way to start your research pathway.

To be eligible for the grant the applicant must be a present member of the UK RPG.

Review Process

Proposals will be reviewed by the RPG Research and Development Team and Dr Ruth Bednall.

Reports and Publication

It is expected that the project will be commenced within 6 months of notification of the award or funding may be withdrawn.

An interim report of progress will be expected by the RPG at an agreed time with the lead applicant, but no later than 6 months into the project. The report is expected to contain the following aspects:

- Members of the research team and their role within the team
- Outline of achievement so far, and timeline to completion
- Any delays/issues that have arisen since undertaking the project and how they will be addressed

It is expected that an update of progress will be presented to the RPG members at the following conference 2021, and a final presentation of the results at the following conference in 2022. Abstract submission is expected to the relevant conferences outlined in your proposal and submission of a research paper to a relevant peer-reviewed healthcare professional journal.

The involvement of the Renal Pharmacy Group must be recognised in all publications, papers or posters arising from the research that the grant from the RPG has supported.

Intellectual Property Rights, Patents & Copyright

Consent must be obtained from the RPG Research and Development Team before pursuance of any proposal arising from any RPG funded research which may lead to commercial development. Consent may well be conditional and dependent upon agreement for the RPG to share any ensuing financial benefit.

Employment of Staff

The RPG does not act as an employer, in all cases where support for the employment of staff is given, the host institution must issue a contract of employment.

The RPG does not accept liability for claims of compensation under any statue or common law, nor will they indemnify the host institution against any claim for compensation or other claim for which the host institution may be liable as an employer.

Financial Arrangements

Funding of up to £5000 will be utilised to help deliver the proposed project and help develop the applicants research skills. Payment arrangements will be agreed with relevant parties and the RPG prior to release of funds.

Termination of Grant

The RPG Research and Development Team reserve the right, without notice, to terminate a grant if they so wish. The RPG will reimburse the relevant parties for expenditure properly incurred under the grant up to the termination day, but will not be responsible for, nor indemnify, the host institution against any matters arising from the employment of staff.

Limitation of RPG Liability

The RPG is not responsible, financially or otherwise, for the expenditure or liabilities arising out of the research work other than that formally agreed with the RPG.
